

VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT

Don Kisicki

Don Kisicki has worked in the McKenna Center kitchen two days a week for more than a decade through the Ignatian Volunteer Corps. According to Volunteer and Food Pantry Manager Emily Dold, Don exemplifies the mission of the McKenna Center of providing comfort to others. Don even ran the kitchen full-time when the McKenna Center was between Kitchen Managers. He can be found standing at the sink until the very last dish is washed. Current Kitchen Manager Russell Byrd calls him a brother.

More than 10 years ago, when Executive Director Dennis Dee arrived at the McKenna Center at the lowest point in his life, Don sensed his need for a kind gesture and gave him an extra pastry. Don is such a part of the McKenna Center that he attends weekly staff meetings and closes these gatherings with a meaningful prayer and thoughts.



HYPOTHERMIA TRANSITION PROGRAM TO START NOVEMBER 1ST

Each year, the McKenna Center houses up to a dozen men through the Hypothermia Transition Program from November 1 through March 31. The men are selected based on an assessment of their readiness to move out of homelessness through a job, permanent or temporary housing, and commitment to sobriety and mental health.

The McKenna Center provides our guests with a clean bed, shower, case management, and breathing room to get their life in order in a predictable environment. Members of the Gonzaga Mothers Club provide a home-cooked meal each night.

Darren Staton recently visited the McKenna Center. He is a graduate of the 2015-2016 Hypothermia Transition Program. Since graduating, Darren has secured a stable job and lives with his wife and children. Darren is one of many men the McKenna Center has helped to reclaim their lives.
